## Phones Away For the Day – Personal Devices included

As mentioned in a previous newsletter, schools have been mandated to implement a phone rule that has student phones 'away for the day'. At Pinehaven School we do not recommend students bring personal devices to school. If students do bring a phone and/or a personal device to school it is expected that these are not for use during the school day and must be turned off and out of sight. Recently, I have noticed an increasing number of students with smart devices such as watches. These also come under the new policy. Please support us by talking with your child about any devices they bring to school and also the need for these devices, watches included, to be away for the day once at school.
